

Cyclist safety in your worksite

Cyclist safety at road work sites is a key focus of VicRoads and Bike Safe. Moving into the warmer weather, you will notice more traffic and more cyclists around your worksite. When setting up traffic management, it is important to consider how placing signs on the road impact on the interaction between cyclists, traffic and work activities.



Key Point 1: Where possible, keep signage out of the space cyclists ride. A minimum of 1 metre should be provided for cyclists to pass safely.

Key Point 2: Where bike lanes/shoulders are removed, make use of advanced warning signs

When setting up your site, please take the time to consider how the placement of signage will impact cyclists. Small changes to the signage set up will reduce the risk of cyclists being injured, and reduce cyclist frustration towards you and your workers.
